In July 2017, the overall Consumer Price Index was 192.99, a 0.38 percent increase over the June 2017 overall index of 190.15

On an annual basis the overall index increased by 8.06 percent from July 2016 to July 2017. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 8.73 percent whilst Non-Food Products and Services rose by 6.89 percent.

From July 2016 to July 2017, within the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, ‘Fish and fish products’ increased by 12.57 percent, ‘Meat and meat products’ increased by 11.15 percent and ‘Bread and Cereal’ increased by 9.03 percent.

For the Non-Food items, major increases were recorded by ‘Footwear’, ‘Clothing, Garments and tailoring services’ and ‘Electricity, Gas and other Fuels’ which rose by 12.11 percent, 7.45 percent and 5.57 percent respectively.

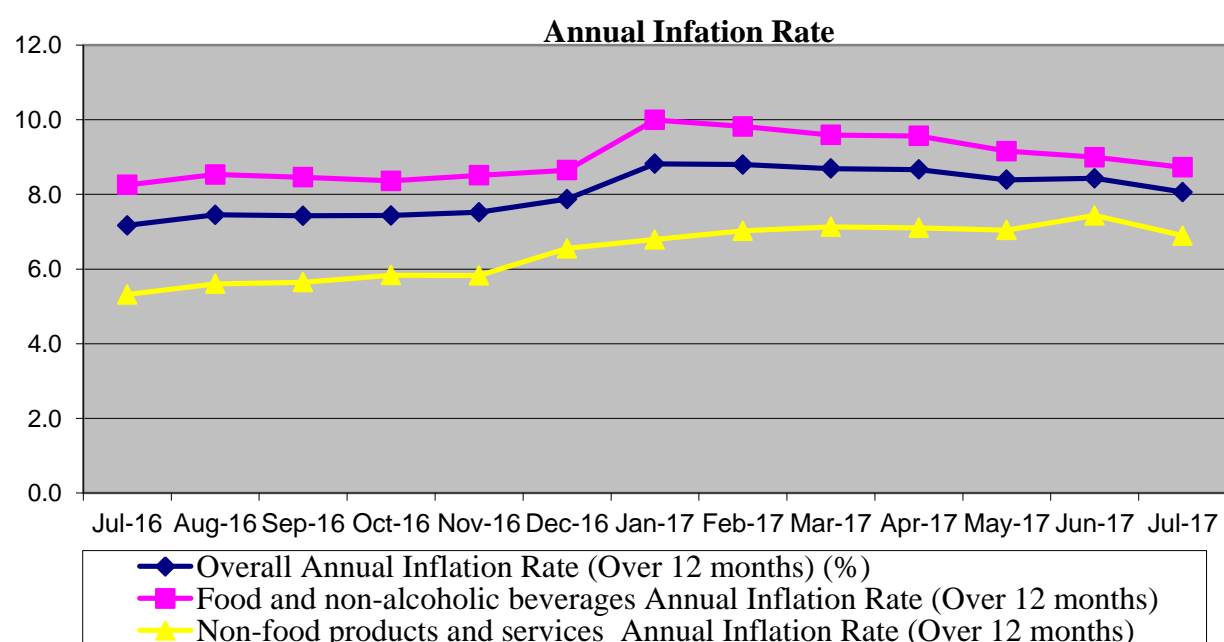
During the months of June 2017 to July 2017, ‘Meat and meat products’, ‘Milk, Cheese and Eggs’, and ‘Fish and fish products’ shows the highest increase in percentage with 0.72 percent, 0.64 percent, and 0.60 percent respectively.

Using the 12 months-moving-average measure, inflation rate was 8.14 percent in July 2017 compared to 8.07 percent recorded in June 2017.

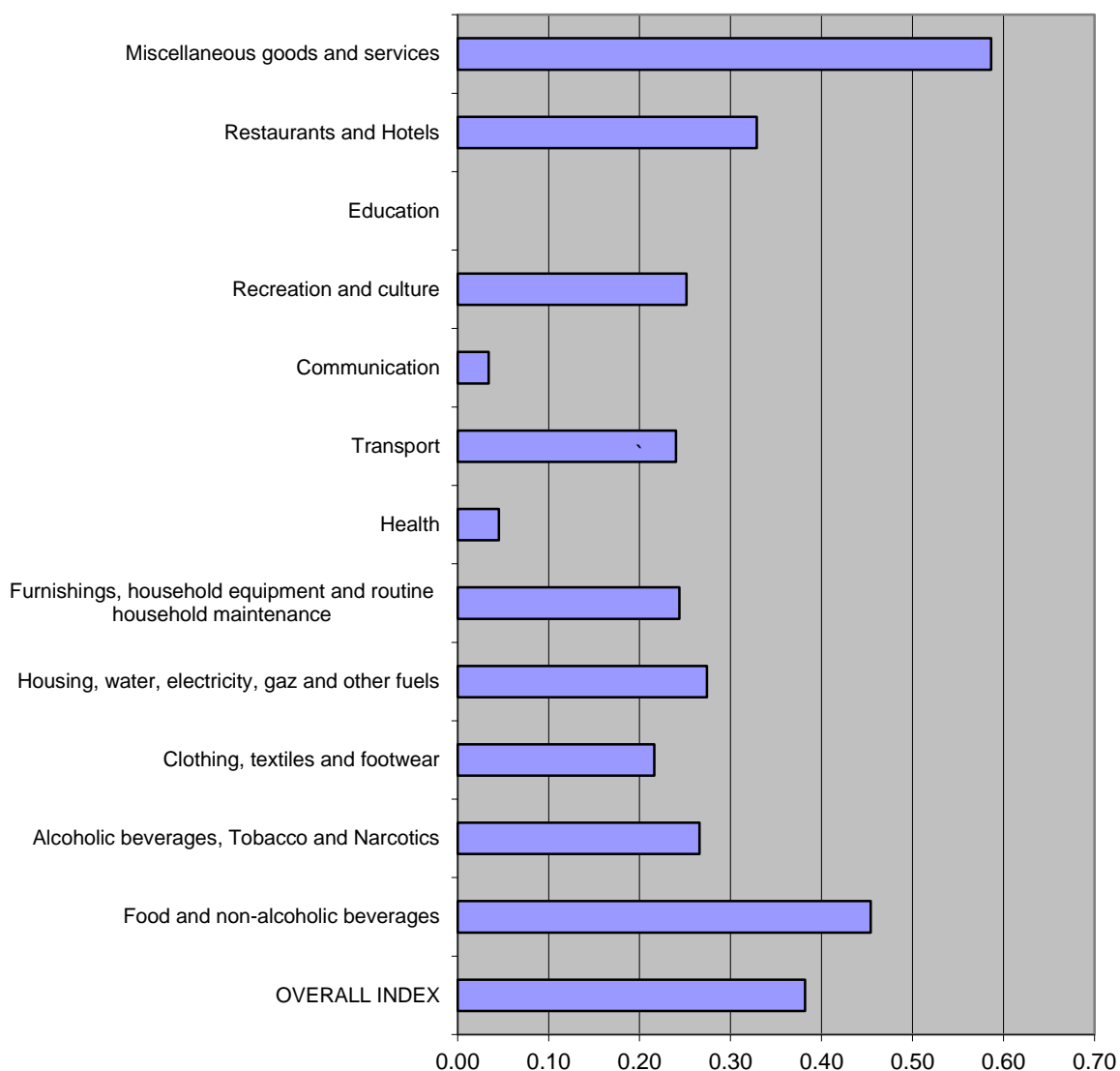
