Important announcement

With the publication of the January 2020 index, GBoS has updated the official CPI series. This involves updating the weights and product basket as well as a number of methodological improvements. These updates improve the transparency, relevance and representativity of the CPI. For the first time, GBoS will also be calculating CPI indexes for urban and rural areas. These estimates are available on our website. See www.gbosdata.org/downloads, www.gambia.opendataforafrica.org/nsdp or the Annex to this release for full details.

To highlight these improvements, the long run CPI index has been re-referenced (rescaled) to January 2020=100. Please note that historical inflation rates are unaffected by this rescaling.

From June 2022 to June 2023 the year-on-year All-items Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation rate increased by 17.81 percent. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages increased by 22.99 percent whilst Non-Food Products increased by 11.48 percent.

In June 2023, the All-items CPI was 144.49, an increase of 1.14 percent over the May 2023 All-items index of 142.85.

From June 2022 to June 2023, within Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, 'Fish' increased by 32.55 percent, 'Vegetable, Root Crops and Tubers' increased by 31.82 percent, 'Other Food Products N.E.C' increased by 30.10 percent, 'Milk, Cheese and Eggs' increased by 27.39 percent, 'Bread and Cereals' increased by 22.35 percent, 'Sugar, Jam, Honey and Sweets' increased by 19.15 percent, 'Meat' increased by 15.82 percent, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 14.90 percent, 'Oils and Fats' increased by 13.89 percent and 'Non-alcoholic Beverages' increase by 13.16 percent.

Over the same period, for the Non-Food products, major increases were recorded by 'Education', 59.71 percent, 'Recreation and Culture', 35.44 percent, 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels', 31.96 percent, 'Hotel, Café and Restaurant', 21.33 percent, 'Furnishing, Household Equipment ETC.' 17.28 percent, 'Clothing and Footwear', 12.28 percent, 'Transport', 4.69 percent, 'Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics' 4.03 percent, 'Miscellaneous', 3.74 percent, and 'Health' 2.60 percent.

From May 2023 to June 2023, the highest inflation rates within the Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages were for; 'Vegetable, Root Crops and Tubers' increased by 3.45 percent, 'Fruits and Nuts' increased by 2.70 percent, 'Oils and Fats' increased by 1.43 percent, 'Non-alcoholic Beverages' increase by 1.38 percent. 'Sugar, Jam, Honey and Sweets, 1.34 percent, 'Fish' increased by 0.97 percent, 'Bread and Cereals' increased by 0.71 percent, 'Other Food Products N.E.C' increased by 0.50 percent, and 'Meat', increased by 0.36 percent. 'Milk, Cheese and Eggs' increased by 0.36 percent,

Also, from May 2023 to June 2023, the highest inflation rates within the Non-Food Products and Services were for, 'Furnishing, Household Equipment ETC.' 2.99 percent, 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels', 2.88 percent, 'Clothing and Footwear', 1.83 percent, 'Hotel, Cafes, and Restaurant 1.32 percent, 'Recreation and Culture', 0.72 percent, and 'Miscellaneous' 0.37 percent.

Using the 12-months-moving-average measure, the annual inflation rate was 16.81 percent in June 2023 compared to 16.48 percent recorded in May 2023.

Figure 1: Annual changes – Comparison with the same month of the previous year (June 2022 – June 2023)

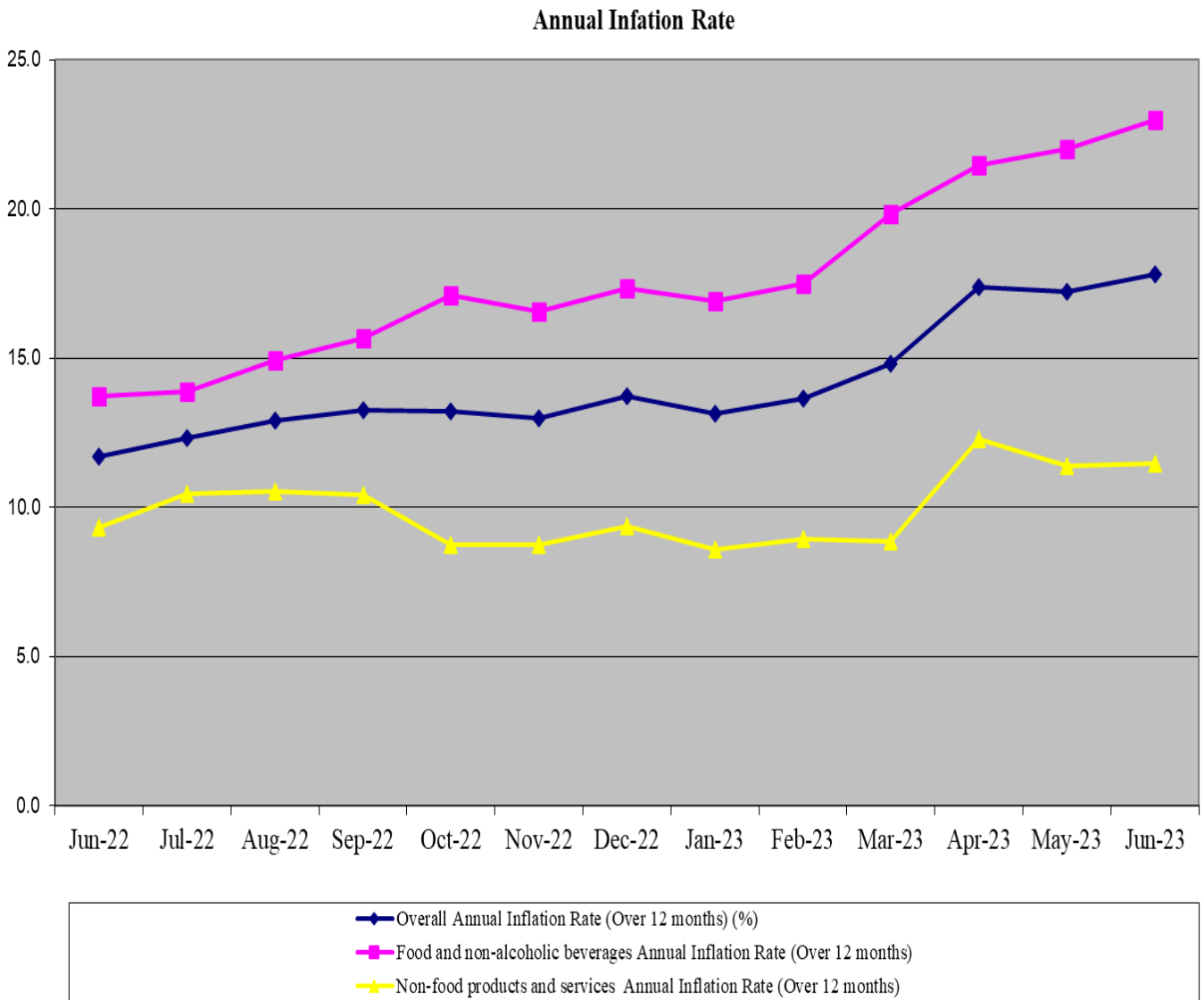
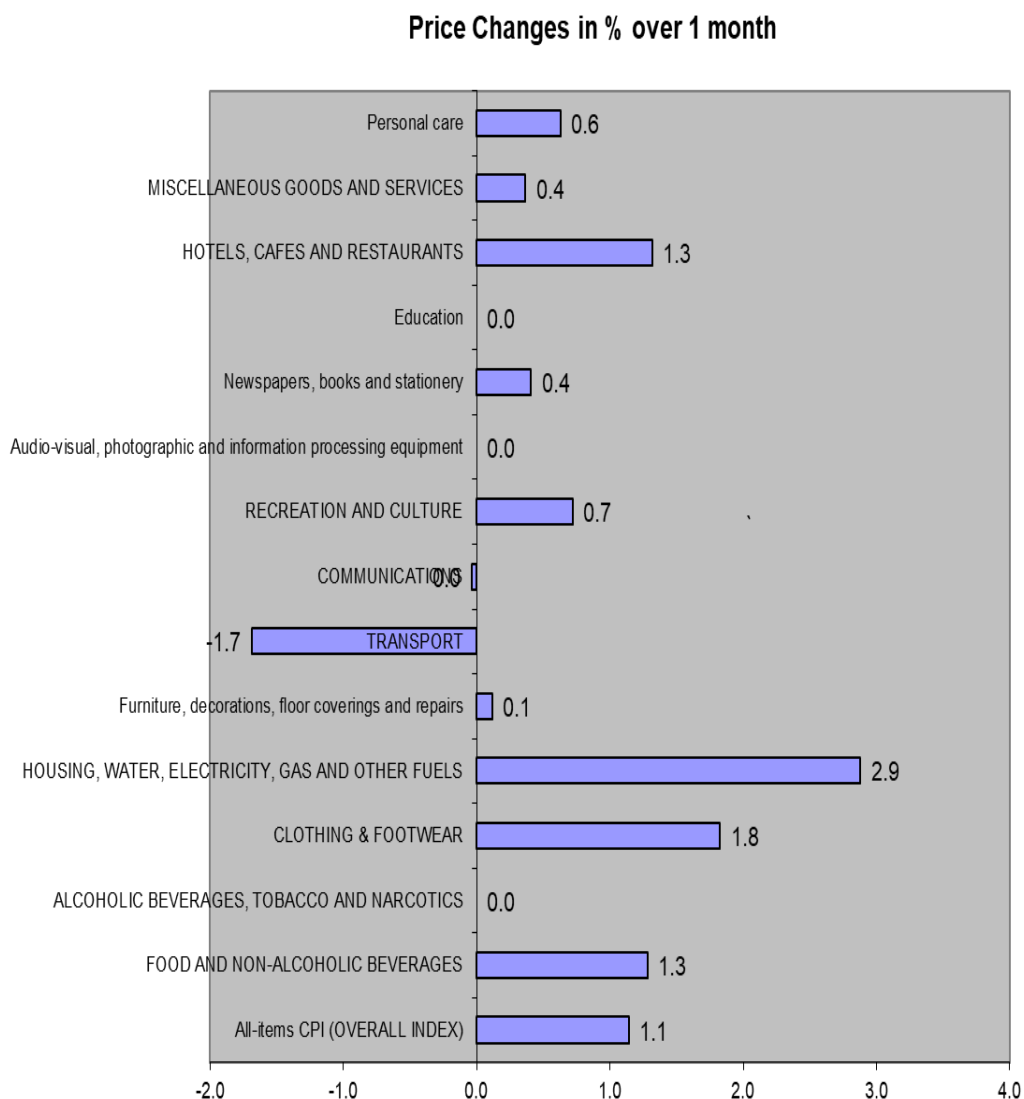


Figure 2: Monthly changes - Comparison with the previous month: May 2023 to June 2023



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
